Dress Code

Dress Code:

Neat and appropriate attire is required on the golf course (including the driving range and practice greens) and in the clubhouse for members and guests at Wilcox Oaks Golf Club.

- **Male Members and Guests:** A shirt with a collar, mock neck or current golf athletic wear, are appropriate for the clubhouse and course. T-shirts are inappropriate. As always, clean, neat and undamaged condition is expected. Shorts should be no shorter than mid-thigh and no longer than knee length (excluding knickers.) Tank tops, sweats, and gym or athletic shorts are not allowed.

Hats can be worn in the clubhouse, except in the dining room.

- **Female Members and Guests:** An appropriate top or shirt is required. Spaghetti straps, halter tops, tank tops, tee shirts, bare midriffs, sweats, gym wear, athletic or spandex shorts are not allowed.

- Swimwear is restricted to the pool area.
- Formal or stylish attire is welcomed in the clubhouse for special occasions. Private parties should be notified of the dress code prior to their event.
- Working crews on premises are exempt from the dress code.

The pro-shop staff is responsible for ensuring golf attire conforms to the code. If a member or other staff has a concern regarding acceptability of dress, their concerns should be directed to the President, General Manager/Director of Golf, if applicable, or in their absence the Board's Designee.
